Start a revolution or head to the beach?

A dilemma arises for Federica and Paola as they ride two bicycles welded to each other. On their tandem they can share their dreams and conflicts, adventures and dangers. Daring curves, breathtaking descents, bumps, overtaking and sun in their eyes. Enveloped by the wind, thoughts are simple, and may seem to have no consequences. In this world of boys, who lies stretched out on the ground in front of Frederica? A part of her, her friend Paola?

These two young friends, held in place on a sculpture, tell stories, ask questions and discuss the fragility of growing up. Inspired by the death of Carlo Guiliani, the young man killed during the G8 summit riots in 2008, this collaborative piece revolves around a stunning tandem sculpture created by **Mario Petriccione**. **Tandem** is a spellbinding physical production of sweaty bodies and energetic relationships from an acclaimed Italian company that invites the audience to view the world through the eyes of young people and witness their change as they grow old.

Civilleri Lo Sicco was formed by Sabino Civilleri and Manuela Lo Sicco.

Originally forming their first company in 1997 with Emma Dante, in 2011 they chose an independent path founding the **A.C. Civilleri Lo Sicco** to help promote international work in their home country of Italy. The award-winning duo lead a large number of theatre focusing on group dynamics, choral listening and the relationship between theatre and sport. Committed to being an international home for artists to develop, open to collaboration and sharing of ideas, they began a series of artists residences with young actors which led to their first show, *Physical Education* debuting in Milan in 2001.
