Carpet dealers, chain smoking octogenarians and shy village heroes bring about a chain of improbable, synchronistic events in this struggle to honor these last Kurdish storytellers.

A featured storyteller on National Public Radio, at the National Storytelling Festival and the International Storytelling Center, Diane is known for her unique style of telling where she embodies the various characters and scenes in a tale, bringing each moment alive. For this, she has won the first and only National Oracle Award for Storytelling Excellence in the Northeast as well as five **Storytelling World Awards**.
