

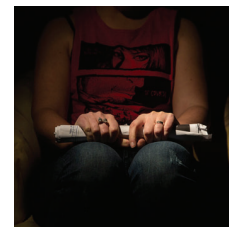

### **Award-winning Majorcan company bring a true life story of psychological pain to the Edinburgh Festival Fringe**

**Foehn Effect** is a one-woman solo show based on the real life experiences of the actress. During the performance she takes the audience on a unique journey through the psychological pain and emotional stages that she passed through after being sexually assaulted: depression, anger, loss of humanity and sense of injustice...

This monologue, written, directed and performed by **Christina Gavel**, is a unique and extraordinary work that rediscovers and reconnects the human contact of the theatre. It contains staggering vulnerability, exploring the actress's pain via an intimate theatrical performance. Pain, suffering, death... Universal themes that have been reflected throughout literature, from Greek tragedy to Shakespeare, up to more contemporary authors such as Sarah Kane or Angelica Liddell.

**Res de Res & En Blanc** is a Majorcan based theatre production company established in 2000. Since their formation they have focused on physical theatre and particularly on the integration of specific circus techniques into their performances. The company has performed in fourteen different countries across the globe and were awarded the **Total Theatre Award** at the Edinburgh Festival Fringe for (*remor*) in 2012. Christina Gavel has studied musical theatre and the dramatic arts in many prestigious institutions. Some of the highlights of her work include *L'enemic* and *La incompresa*, directed by **Joan Fullana**, the musical *Rent: La Vie Boheme* and several short films.
