Absurdist dark comedy **23, Please: The Sketch Show That Never Was** starts and ends in the hallucinating mind of a boy cleaning out his room. Having been given a tablet of LSD by his well-intentioned father hoping to teach him about the dangers of drugs, he has a sequence of visions correlating to the clutter of 23 objects located within the confines of his bedroom. He begins to wonder if he will ever emerge from this trip and more importantly, will his room ever get clean?

A surreal and fast-paced comedy with zippy punch lines, rewardingly bizarre scenarios, and an array of characters that could exist only in the mind of a boy undergoing a severely psychedelic lesson; the show unfolds over the course of an hour as 23 objects become the subject of 23 sketches.

Two Thirds Comedy consists of **Adam Woolf, Enrico Hallworth** and **Rufus McAlister**, making their Edinburgh Fringe debut. They have written and performed in multiple sketch shows, musicals and pantomimes together, and have received acclaim on the student scene.
