1 in 10 Gay men in the UK are HIV Positive, and its rising.
3000 gay men seek help at 56 Dean St for Chem-Sex addiction a month.
GHB and other overdoses are common, killing vulnerable gay men.
Addiction is destroying lives. Its a public health crisis. We need to talk.

Winner of the Brighton Fringe Award for best LGBTQ theatre 2016. Winner of the Doric Wilson Intercultural Dialogue Award and Best Actor award at Dublin International Gay Theatre Festival 2016.

Since the start of the fringe, the 5 Guys Chillin' team has given out over 6000 condoms, and raised over £600 for Waverley Cares new SX Project for men who have sex with men. Alistair Rose Said: "Multipul people saw the play last week and came to us to talk about issues it raised with them"

Created from 5 peoples interviews and informed by over 50 hours of materiel from guys found through Grindr and other social media, this is an important look at the relatively new scene that apps have been fundamental in creating. Chem-Sex is considered by the NHS to be a public health issue, HIV rates in London rising, its time to talk about this.
