Carried by a marathon effort from a young actress in the role as Andrea, *Fear No Colours'* production brings this haunting story closer than ever in the company's most intimate work to date, challenging the boundaries between performer and audience.

**Fear No Colours** is a Glasgow-based theatre company committed to visceral and bold productions of contemporary British plays. Following their critically acclaimed debut pieces *Cleansed* and *Phaedra's Love* by Sarah Kane at the 2015 Edinburgh Festival Fringe, the company are back and ready to push boundaries even further this season. *Fear No Colours* are also performing **Mercury Fur** by **Philip Ridley** at **C venues** at the 2016 Edinburgh Festival Fringe.
