What does it mean to be gay and Muslim? A contentious new play exploring the harsh realities faced by queer people of colour

Submission tells the story of Sameer, a young British Pakistani, who struggles to reconcile his sexual desires with his Islamic roots. On the day of his 23rd birthday, Sameer hosts an unprecedented after-party with a friend. A series of unwelcome events unfold, triggering an unhinged response in Sameer. Not only does he question his faith, he also begins to acknowledge the cruel realities faced by queer people of colour.

Torn between his allegiance to Mecca and his desire for temporal modernity, Sameer recites spoken word-cum-Quranic compositions, poignantly integrating age-old philosophy with new-wave ideology. Using powerful verse and dynamic physical theatre against the backdrop of conventional naturalism, **Submission** is not only unique and contentious, but forces audiences to contemplate the importance of integration and harmony in increasingly troubling, terror-inducing times.

Liver and Lung Productions is a critically acclaimed and award-winning international theatre company. Their plays, musicals and events in London, Edinburgh and Malaysia have reached a wide audience. *Mahsuri and Other Perculiar Tales*, an original musical, recently won Malaysia's National Boh Cameronian Arts Award for Innovation in Musical Theatre. This is their third year at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival.
